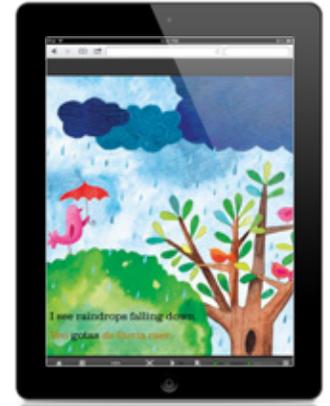

From the research

In school, direct and frequent opportunities to interact in English are needed for language development (Wong Fillmore, & Snow, 2002), and it is through negotiation of meaning that English language learners extend their productive capabilities (Ellis, 1985; Swain, 1995). A language-rich environment that surrounds students with oral and written text provides opportunities for ongoing interaction and engagement in academic conversations (Frey, Fisher, & Rothenberg, 2008; Zwiers, 2008) and writing for a variety of purposes.

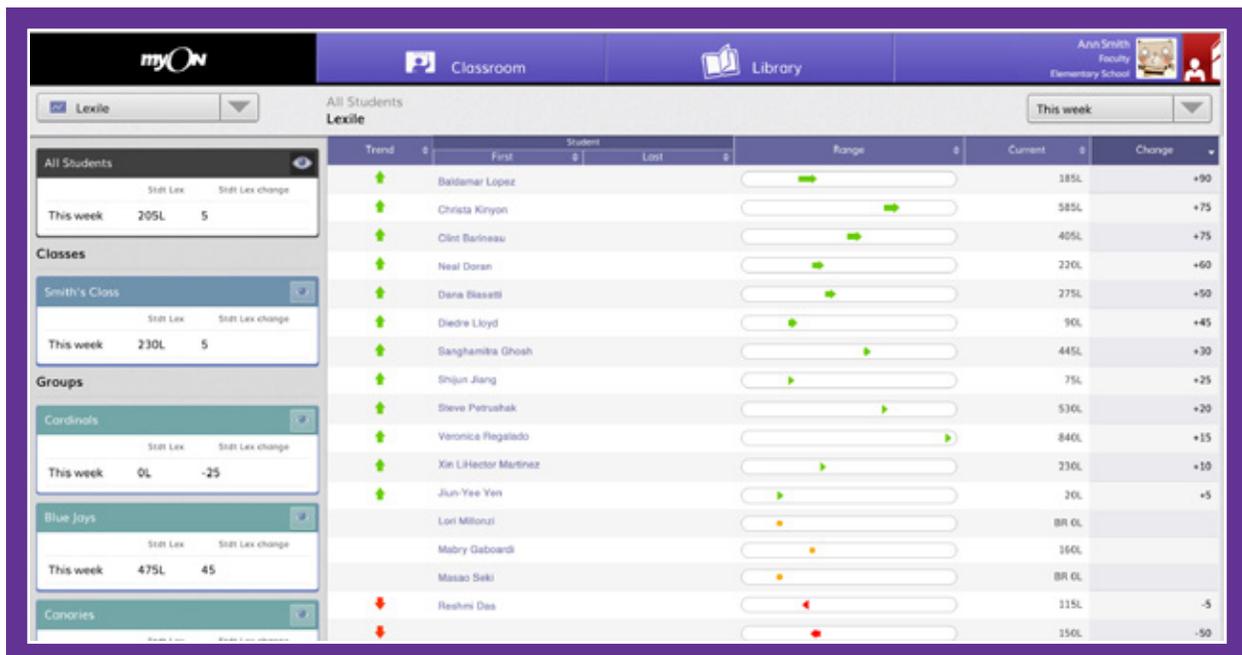
myON monitors reading activity, including:

- › optional end-of-book quizzes that test comprehension, vocabulary, inference and interpretation (use myON quizzes or link to your Accelerated Reader™ quizzes)

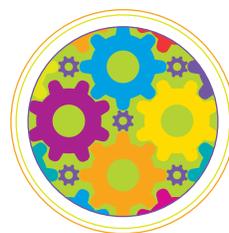
